NARRATIVE

- 1. AO: On Saturday, 7-19-2014, I was dispatched to Shands UF Hospital, to meet with the complainants in reference to a possible stalking / harassing phone call(s) incident. I was in uniform driving a marked police car.
- 2. INV: On scene, I met with and interviewed Charmaine Haugen. The following is a summary of that interview. For several months she has had contact with a subject she knows as Linda Woolwine, whom she met on Facebook. During that time, she has learned that Woolwine and her current live-in boyfriend (of 6 years), Edward Braddy, have been in a sexual relationship since (approx) January 2014. Since learning of the sexual relationship, Woolwine has contacted Haugen via Facebook and on her cellphone. At some point during their mutual contact. Woolwine turned "nasty" toward Haugen, calling her names and a liar (in regard to her long-term relationship with Braddy). The frequency of contact, initiated by Woolwine has escalated to the point where yesterday (7-18-2014) Haugen had to turn her phone off as Woolwine was calling non-stop and she was unable to use her phone due to the repeated, back-to-back calls. I directed Haugen to save the messages on her phone and Facebook page for (possible) use at a later date. She agreed to do so.

I then met with and interviewed Edward Braddy. The following is a summary of that interview. Since about January 2014, Braddy has been involved in a sporadic sexual relationship with Linda Woolwine whom he met on Facebook. Initially, Woolwine would send him provocative, unsolicited private messages. Those messages included nude photos and other racy comments about her willingness to perform sexual acts with/for him. Woolwine would send messages (the same one over and over) and when/if Braddy would respond with a similarly sexually charged response, Woolwine would forward that message - seemingly out of context, as if unsolicited on her part - to Haugen, which led to their (Woolwine vs Haugen) electronic/phone confrontation. According to Braddy, he and Woolwine discussed prior to any sort of intimacy, the limits of these meetings (sexual in nature only, no accompanying relationship). When the verbal agreement between the two about merely a casual, sexual relationship became insufficient for Woolwine, she began to text / call / Facebook message incessantly. Woolwine, at some point during this time period, told Braddy that she worked "with" Law Enforcement and was authorized to carry the gun she possessed. (That information was never confirmed by Braddy, nor was any firearm seen or displayed.) This combination of factors led Braddy to end the sexual relationship and (on or about June 6th, 2014) he requested via text message that she stop contacting him by any means. Woolwine, seemingly scorned, began to post messages on her Facebook about exposing a public figure for corruption or the like. Meanwhile, Braddy blocked (about a month ago) Woolwine's "main" phone number and her personal Facebook. Woolwine began calling and texting from an alternate number which Braddy also blocked, not recognizing the number. Woolwine then created or began using an alternate Facebook page under the name "Jesse Ray" to message Braddy. In those messages, Woolwine identified herself as Linda and directed Braddy to call her or she would go to the media and expose their sexual relationship. Braddy called her at the alternate number and during the conversation, Braddy requested she not contact him any further. Woolwine then demanded that Braddy meet her in person to "end it the right way" or she would expose his infidelities (as he has a long-term, live-in girlfriend, Haugen (not to mention his standing in the community). Braddy refused to meet with her in private as she demanded and said a public meeting would have to suffice. Woolwine refused. Braddy became more concerned for his safety; however he did not specify the nature of his concern. He did say, he could not rule out the possibility of physical harm, however, no overt threats have ever been made toward him or his family. Thinking the matter to be concluded, Braddy went about attending to a family matter

involving medical attention. Braddy seemed genuinely disappointed in himself and this series of choices and apologized for his actions to me leading up to my involvement.

Yesterday, Woolwine, having "heard" Braddy made a verbal comment to a mutual friend about the veracity of any claim(s) made by Woolwine; Woolwine began to incessantly message Braddy from the Facebook accounts she had access to. The number of messages which Braddy did not respond to, exceeded 100 - in less than a 24 hour span. I directed Braddy to save the messages to his phone and Facebook account for (possible) use at a later date. He agreed to do so.

Neither Haugen nor Braddy wished to complete a written statement.

I requested Ofc Zawadzki construct a photo line-up containing the suspect.

I showed the line-up to Braddy. Braddy immediately pointed to the suspect, Woolwine. Braddy followed the instructions from form 311, by circling and signing the photo of Woolwine, I placed the date and time near his signature, while still in his presence (positive identification).

I attempted to contact Woolwine, by phone, when she called in to Combined Communications Center and requested to speak to an officer about her interaction(s) with Braddy. I left a message at the number she provided the CCC but contact was never made.

On 7-20-2014, Braddy contacted me by phone and said Woolwine had called him and left a message requesting a meeting now that she had calmed down, but the urgency in the meeting was gone, as she said tomorrow (Monday, 7-21-2014) would be fine. Woolwine also sent Braddy a Facebook message, similar in nature. Braddy did not speak to Woolwine nor did he return her message.

On 7-21-2014, Braddy contacted me to report that he had not received any contact from Woolwine during the overnight hours but said that during the research I asked him to conduct, he discovered more messages / attempts from Woolwine, which were from the blocked number. No other contact had been attempted since our earlier conversation.

I, again, attempted contact with Woolwine via a recorded phone patch through CCC at about noon, this day. My intention was to outline my investigation up to this point and request a meeting (in a voicemail should she not answer). However, Woolwine did answer and after I introduced myself, she asked me if this call was in reference to Braddy. When I said that it was, Woolwine began to talk about the case without questioning or prompting. She spoke almost non-stop and gave me very little time to speak or respond. In her nearly 30 minute monologue, she admitted to all of the allegations against her and eventually agreed to meet with me at her apartment building, in the lobby several hours later.

At approx 1400 hours at 2306 SW 13th St, Lakeshore Towers, in the lobby, I met with Woolwine whom I immediately recognized from her DAVID photo. I had requested Ofc Hinson go with me in the event an arrest was made / attempted. I read Woolwine her Miranda warning from my GPD issued Miranda card, in Ofc Hinson's presence. After acknowledging her Miranda rights, Woolwine verbally waived her rights and agreed to speak to me without an attorney present. Woolwine indicated that she was currently "seeing" an attorney and wanted to call him before continuing the interview. Woolwine returned a short time later and stated she wished to go forward with the interview and began telling her side of the story. The following is a summary of that interview.

Post Miranda, Woolwine said she had been in a sexual relationship with Braddy since the beginning of the year (Jan 2014). She said Braddy represented himself (on Facebook) as a single man so she thought he was available to jointly pursue a relationship. She said she eventually found out about Haugen (via Facebook) and even after knowing he was romantically involved with Haugen and had been for years, she continued the sexual relationship with Braddy. When the relationship began to dwindle, she asked Braddy if it was because of Haugen, she claimed he did not respond with the "truth" or enough truth to satisfy her. So she began to message / call / attempt to contact Braddy, incessantly, to get him to meet with her privately. Woolwine admitted to sending Braddy a "ton" of messages in a relatively short period of time and to "pressuring him" by threatening to publicly out him about their liaison should he not meet with her alone to "end it the right way." Woolwine explained (the meaning of) that statement as most likely having sex again but denied threatening Braddy with any sort of physical harm - ever, during their brief relationship. She indicated that she was "willing to leave the door open" to a continued sexual relationship with Braddy had he shown her the honesty she desired (thus the reason for the private meeting).

When asked about the barrage of calls to Haugen, she said she was never told not to call "Charmaine," but admitted to calling her back-to-back on multiple occasions, admitting further to calling during the instance Haugen reported as harassing phone calls. Woolwine denied calling Haugen when she was unable to reach Braddy. In summary, Woolwine freely admitted, Post Miranda, to committing all the law violations, alleged against her.

During my in-car video taped interview, Woolwine would not consent to an examination of her computer, however, she alleged to have a plethera of text messages, Facebook messages, "sexts" and the like. Woolwine attempted to access her computer to show me these items

but she was unable to gain access during our meeting. I directed Woolwine to save the messages on both of her cell phones and Facebook accounts for (possible) use at a later date. She agreed to do so.

Braddy and Haugen had indicated they would sign Complaint Withdrawals for these crimes in the event Woolwine was amenable to severing all contact with them, to include, calls / texts / messages / emails / Facebook messages / etc.. Woolwine agreed and her portion of the Complaint Withdrawal was fully explained to her. She said she understood and would not be contacting either of them ever again.

I later met with Braddy and Haugen who signed their respective Complaint Withdrawals. I turned both completed forms over to the GPD Records Department for attachment to this electronic report. Independently, Haugen was shown a photo line-up containing Woolwine. After completing GPD form 311, Haugen viewed the photo line-up and selected the photo of Woolwine by circling / signing / and placing the date / time thereto.

- 3. EV: The photo line-ups and completed GPD form 311s, signed by Braddy and Haugen were later placed into GPD Property and Evidence. A copy of the completed line-ups and forms were submitted to the GPD Records Department for attachment to this electronic report.
- 4. SCA: I have developed probable cause to arrest Linda F Woolwine, W/F, 5-28-68, for Stalking (simple) and Harassing Phone Calls. Both victims (Braddy and Haugen) have completed Complaint Withdrawals (respectively), submitted to GPD Records.
- 5. VEH: N/A
- 6. ADD: During this investigation, I sought input from my Shift Commander, Lt Dan Stout and ASA Steve Frisco. Lt Stout also, at some point, spoke to GPD Legal Advisor, Lee Libby. I used input from each to determine the course of action I felt best suited these specific circumstances. Lt Stout notified my entire Chain-of-Command prior to our end-of-duty (XO-Lt Ferrara, Patrol Commander-Capt Posey, Major Hanna and Chief Jones).

My in-car camera was on during my interview with Woolwine. I told Ofc Andrew Hinson he would not need to complete a report since his presence / interaction was during the time my in-car camera was activated which could stand as an accurate representation of his involvement. I recommend that this case be reviewed for closure in 1 year, if no other violations have occurred. No further action at this time.
