INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER

A PUBLIC HEARING ON A RESOLUTION TO CONSIDER RENAMING PORTIONS OF TWENTIETH STREET BETWEEN CASTRO STREET AND HARRISON STREET TO THOMAS BERKLEY WAY

WHEREAS, Sections 34091.1 and 34092 of the California Government Code authorize the City Council to change the name of any existing City street; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Vice Mayor Larry Reid has requested that the City rename 20<sup>h</sup> Street between Castro Street and Harrison Street; and

WHEREAS, staff held community meeting on April 18, 2002 to inform all affected residents, property owners and businesses of the street name change; and

WHEREAS, staff mailed notices to affected residents, property owners and business owners to solicit responses in support or opposition of the street name change; and

WHEREAS, staff clearly stated in the notification letter that non-response would be construed as support for the street name change; and

WHEREAS, 78% of the residents, businesses and property owners did not object to the street name change; and

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2002 at the regularly scheduled meeting, the City Council set May 7, 2002 as a public hearing date for this matter; and

WHEREAS, cost for fabricating, installing and processing of the street name change is borne by the project proponent; and

WHEREAS, the request for street name change was initiated by Vice Mayor and Council Member of District Seven, Larry Reid; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City of Oakland to rename Twentieth Street, between Castro Street and Harrison Street; and

WHEREAS, the affected street area is delineated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owners, residents and businesses had the opportunity to express their concerns about the street name change; and so therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council approve the resolution renaming 20<sup>th</sup> Street between Castro Street and Harrison Street subject to Council identification of the funding source for the new street name signs and processing fee; and

RESOLVED: That the City Council will make a determination whether to waive \$5,874.00 for fabricating and installing of street name signs and \$2,723.00 processing fee when the matter is heard; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to have a copy of this resolution recorded with Alameda County Records Office upon payment of any fees due; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That from the date of approval of this resolution the portions of 20<sup>th</sup> Street between Castro Street and Harrison Street will become 20<sup>th</sup> Street/ Thomas Berkley Way for the first three years and Thomas Berkley Way thereafter.
