

IN CIRCUIT COURT.

The jury in the case of W. H. Cooper vs. O. E. Jacobs returned a verdict in circuit court here in favor of the plaintiff, awarding damages in the amount of \$170. It was claimed by the plaintiff that the defendant owed him a sum of money for labor performed in Lawrence county at a saw-mill belonging to the latter. The case was brought here from Lawrence circuit court.

L. B. Poindexter of Walnut Ridge represented Cooper, while Jacobs was represented by Jones & Campbell of Newport.

In circuit court today the case of T. F. Leonard vs. W. F. Shaw is in progress. The case grew out of a misunderstanding concerning some land. Leonard is represented by S. M. Casey and McCaleb & Reeder, and Shaw is defended by D. H. Coleman.
