

"Orchard Planting"

- Regular planting of ornamental trees along Soquel Drive frontage to create "Farm" view. Trees to be Flowering Plum, Flowering Cherry and Flowering Crab Apple

Play / Sports Area

- 3,500 sq ft Skateboarding area with various street skating elements. Fenced enclosure with locking gate.
- Half-court Basketball area
- Backstop for tennis or handball

Nature Trail

- Stabilized decomposed granite trail along edge of ravine
- Interpretive signs identifying native plants, habitat areas, and 'riparian' communities
- New native plantings on park side of trail

Nature Area

- Looped stabilized decomposed granite trail connecting to primary park path
- Possible site for future expansion of recreation facilities
- Bocce Ball Court
- Screen plantings along adjacent property line
- New native plantings

Tee Street Entrance

- Lockable Gated Entry
- 15' x 30' prefab Restroom locked at night by park staff
- 4 parking stalls including 1 disabled
- Security lighting
- Interlocking Pavers

Picnic Area

- 2-3 Picnic tables
- Shade trees
- Horseshoe Pit

Neighborhood Play Area

- Walkway with benches and picnic tables
- Play structures for all ages
- Swings / Climber



Lower Parking

- 12 cars w/ 1 accessible space
- Access & parking for Play Area and terrace stairs to Community Building.
- Locking gate to control night use

Community Gardens

- Recalls old 'Farm' character
- Individual garden plots
- Old water tank used as tool shed
- Decorative fencing

Community Building

- Design to replicate style and character of original farm house: wood siding, simple gable roofs & wrap around porch
- Approx. 4,000-5,000 sq ft w. meeting rooms, parks office, public restrooms and upstairs art studio & classroom
- Approx. 3,000-5,000 sq ft terraces for outdoor use
- Terrace garden in front with perennials & annuals
- Small heritage garden
- Security lighting
- Public art feature to be determined

Upper Parking

- 33 cars w/ 2 accessible spaces
- Access and parking for Community Building.
- Locking gate to control night use

Picnic Area

- 3-4 Picnic tables w/ covered park shelter
- 2-3 game tables

Dog Park

- 4-5,000 sq ft
- Screen plantings along adjacent property line
- Fenced perimeter
- Fir Bark surface
- Benches / Doggie Water Fountain
- Waste Bags / Receptacle
- Bulletin Board

Pedestrian Bridge

- 50-60 feet long. Prefabricated wood/steel structure
- Raised above ravine w/ adjacent railings & fences to keep people out of ravine
- Locking gates at bridge entrances
- "No Smoking" signs

Outdoor Display / Meeting Area

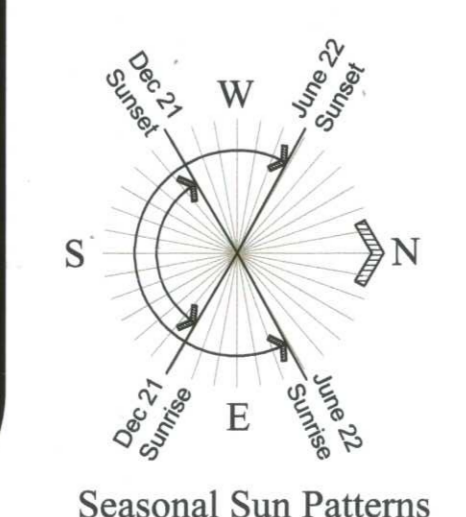
- Covered Trellis arbor at perimeter
- Circular meeting area of decomposed granite, pavers, or concrete

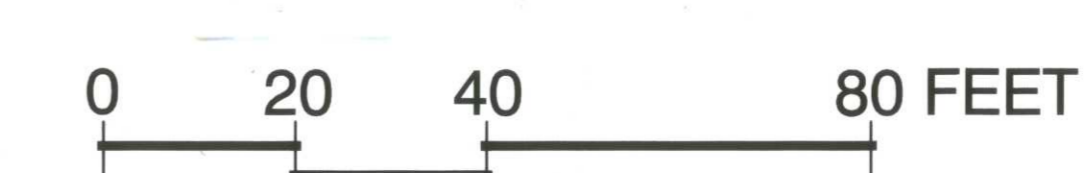
